#### Children's Museum

Build on your kids' excitement about the Olympics with a visit to the new Children's Museum of Phoenix, where they can make Olympic flags from 10 a.m. to noon and 1 to 3 p.m. today. Other activities in the museum's art studio include story times and making finger puppets. The museum, with such interactive exhibits as "Scattered Colors," "Texture Cafe" and the "Grand Ballroom," is open 9 a.m.-4 p.m. Tuesdays through Sundays at the historical Monroe School building, 215 N. Seventh St. It's usually closed Mondays but will be open Sept. 1 for Labor Day visits. Admission is \$9, free for kids younger than 1.
